- TALK and LISTEN to your student(s) everyday about what was learned at school.
 - Sharing your love and interest in learning models and motivates students.
- Build an on-going safe relationship and conversation with your teachers.
 - The number one indicator of students success in school is when the school and communicate back-n-forth on a routine basis.
 - Phone calls, e-mails, and scheduled appointments are the best ways to stay in contact with your teachers and the school.
- Support our PTO!
 - You make us all better when you volunteer for any of the many school activities supported by the MPES PTO.
